Logging Into Moodle with 1Password

❖ Step 1: Open Your Browser

- Open Google Chrome, Safari, or any other browser.

❖ Step 2: Go to the Moodle Website

- In the address bar at the top of your browser, type:

❖ Step 4: Fill in Your Moodle Login

- Fill in your details given by the MFMAC Admin and log in.
 - **Username**
 - **Password**

❖ Step 6: You're In!

- You will now see your Moodle Dashboard with all your courses.

Navigating with Moodle

❖ Navigating the Moodle Dashboard

Once logged in:

1. You'll land on your **Dashboard**
2. Here you'll see:
 - A list of all your **Enrolled Courses**
 - Upcoming deadlines
 - A **Calendar** with important dates
3. Click on any **Course Title** to enter that course
4. Use the **Navigation Menu on the left** to move between sections like:
 - "Grades"

- “Participants”
- “Announcements”
- “Assignments”

❖ Uploading Assignments or Documents

To submit an assignment:

1. Go to your course.
2. Scroll to find the **Assignment** you need to submit.
3. Click on the **Assignment Title**.
4. Read the instructions, then click **“Add Submission”**.
5. Drag your file or click **“Upload”** to attach a document (PDF, Word, etc.).
6. Click **“Save changes”** or **“Submit Assignment”** (if final).
7. You’ll get a **Confirmation Message** once it’s uploaded successfully.

❖ Using BigBlueButton for Live Sessions

To attend an online lecture:

1. Go to your course page
2. Click on the **BigBlueButton link** (your instructor will usually name it something like "Live Class" or "Join Lecture")
3. Click **“Join session”**
4. Choose **“Microphone”** or **“Listen only”** when prompted
5. Use the Panel to:
 - Mute/unmute your mic
 - Raise your hand
 - Chat with the group
 - Share your webcam or screen (if allowed)

Troubleshooting Tips

Problem	Solution
Can't log in to Moodle	Double-check the details given.
File won't upload	Check the file type/size. Try a different browser

Can't join BigBlueButton	Make sure your mic/camera permissions are allowed. Refresh the page
Assignment not submitted	Always look for a “Submitted for grading” message. If unsure, resubmit
Still stuck?	Email support@mfmac.org for help

How to Use Moodle

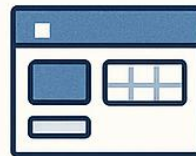
Step by Step



1 Login

Go to your institution's Moodle website.

Step 2 Access Your Dashboard



After logging in, click Dashboard from the menu.

Step 3 Open a Course



Click the course name to open it

You'll see sections like *General* and *Weekly Topics*

Step 4 Find Course Materials



Look under each section for PDFs, slides, or links uploaded by our tutor.

Step 5 Find Assignments



Go to the Assignments activity.

Click *Add submission*, upload your file, then *Submit*

Step 6 Take Quizzes & Exams



Select the Quiz activity, Follow the instructions, answer questions and click *Submit all and finish*

Step 7 Check Grades & Feedback



In the course, click *Grades* from left menu
